Hugo Ariëns (1996) is a guitarist, improviser, and composer based in Den Haag. He has a deep fascination for sound that stems from his continuous obsession with the sonic properties of his instrument, the guitar. This drive led him to explore extended techniques and brought him to the prepared guitar. His innovative use of found objects not only expands the sonic palette of the guitar but also challenges traditional notions of playing technique and performance. As a live performer, Hugo is involved in many projects in areas as diverse as pop, jazz, acoustic folk, drone, noise, rock, and ambient music, but his main focus is currently on free improvisation.

The Object Guitar Archive (2023 -)

A work-in-progress archive that documents Hugo's prepared tabletop guitar practice. The Object Guitar Archive is part of the practice method that Hugo developed especially for his instrument, which focuses on exploration and curiosity rather than the internalization of pre-existing musical material. The building blocks of the archive are the questions that arise during the practice sessions — these questions are what drives the practice forward.

"Improvising Object Guitar: Prepared Tabletop Electric Guitar in Improvised Music" (Research Catalogue, 2023)

Hugo's master thesis at the institute of Sonology deconstructs the prepared tabletop electric guitar and reimagines the instrument in the context of improvised music. In this thesis, Hugo poses the prepared guitar as a fundamentally improvisational instrument: one that has improvisation infused in all its facets. For this research Hugo developed new instruments, a new understanding of the history and historical context of the prepared electric guitar, a method for collecting objects, a practice method with the Object Guitar Archive, and a live-performance approach.




